Growing Project update Exciting News – Horshader Growing Project has been picked as a Surf Awards Finalist. The Surf Award is designed to recognise and celebrate community led regeneration, with the aim of rewarding best practises. It is a great honour to be shortlisted alongside two other community led regeneration projects in Scotland. The project team and members of Horshader Community Development have met with the award judges on the 4th Nov at the projects focal point – The Polytunnels, to discuss recent project developments and future aspirations for the community. We will hear if we have been successful on Tuesday the 2nd of Dec.

Four of the polytunnels are due to have power for heat and lighting, in order for the team to grow fruit and veg for longer period throughout the year. New Fruit planting is due to commence on the 1st of Dec. The outdoor bed is almost ready to plant, the orchard is in progress and we are now rainwater harvesting. The project is also due to be represented at the SSM conference. There is lots of exciting things happening.
